AUTHORITY OF THE SCHOOL BUS DRIVER

Pupils transported in a school bus or in a school pupil activity bus shall be under the authority of, and responsible directly to, the driver of the bus, and the driver shall be held responsible for the orderly conduct of the pupils while they are on the bus or being escorted across a street, highway or road. Continued disorderly conduct or persistent refusal to submit to the authority of the driver shall be sufficient reason for a pupil to be denied transportation. A bus driver shall not require any pupil to leave the bus enroute between home and school or other destinations. (Title 5, California Code of Regulations, Section 14103).

PRESENTING PASSES

All students are required to present a current school year bus each time they board the bus.

CONSEQUENCE FOR NO BUS PASS UPON BOARDING:

- 1ST Offense- Written warning given to student by driver
- 2nd Offense- Parent Notified by phone and written warning given to student.
- 3rd Offense- Parent Notified by phone and mail. Written warning given to student.
- 4th Offense- Student will be DENIED transportation for the remainder of the current semester after parent has been notified by phone and mail.

LOST PASSES

The cost for a replacement pass is \$5.00. A replacement pass will only be issued after one of the following:

1. Submits a request for replacement pass in person at the Transportation Office.
2. Purchase a replacement pass on-line at www.MySchoolBucks.com (please send copy of payment with student)
3. Have student give \$5.00 to the bus driver; the Transportation Office will process the replacement pass and the driver will return the replacement pass to the student
